 - a. On site registration will be available on 3pm to 5 pm on Friday at the Pugh's and on Saturday morning 8 am to 9 am at the Pugh's.
- 8. **Fees:** A Nationals Entry Fee of \$40 will cover dinner for one Saturday evening and 1 Moth souvenir.
- 9. **Measurement:** All new Mothboats and sails must be measured prior to racing. A CMBA Measurer will be on site after 12pm on Friday to measure new boats and sails.
