

# Classic Moth Boat National Championship

## Notice of Race

September 18-20, 2020

1. **Organizing Authority:** The organizing authority is the Classic Mothboat Association (CMBA) and the Pasquotank River Yacht Club.
2. **Venue:** The venue is Sarah and John Pugh's house, 900 Riverside Avenue, on the Pasquotank River in Elizabeth City, NC. **Please Note: due to the Covid pandemic, face masks and social distancing will be expected for all skippers and spectators.**
3. **Boat Divisions:** Three divisions of Moth Boats will be racing: Vintage, Generation I Classic and Generation II Classic.
4. The fastest boat, regardless of division, will be the overall National Champion. Championships for all divisions will be recognized.
5. **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as changed by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
6. **Eligibility:** Competitors must be members of the CMBA to race Moths. Membership dues are \$25/annum (\$10/annum for junior sailors, 16 and under) and may be paid at registration.
7. **Registration:** On site registration will take place from 3pm to 5 pm on Friday and on Saturday morning 8 am to 9 am at the Pugh's.
8. **Fees:** An Entry Fee of \$40 will cover racing, dinner for the skipper on Saturday evening, and 1 Moth souvenir. Extra dinner tickets for spectators and family members will be available on site.
9. **Measurement:** All new Moth Boats and sails must be measured prior to racing. A CMBA Measurer will be on site after 12pm on Friday to measure new boats and sails.

Junior's Championship: 1<sup>st</sup> place  
Turtle Trophy: 1<sup>st</sup> place  
Founder's Award: Awarded the oldest competitor sailing at the Nationals

12. **Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions for Nationals will be available at the Skipper's meeting.

13. **Courses:** Course configurations will be identified in the sailing instructions but will generally be triangles, windward/leeward or a combination.

14. **Racing Area:** Racing will be held in the Pasquotank River generally in the area between Pugh's pier and the Elizabeth city waterfront.
