Organizing Authority: The organizing authorities are the Classic Mothboat Association (CMBA), and River City Community Sailing. With tremendous amount of help from the Pasquotank River Yacht Club, Elizabeth City Parks and Rec, College of the Albermarle and East Coast Sailing.

Venue: The venue for the Moths is John and Sarah Pugh's house, 900 Riverside Avenue, the other boats will be at CG park and or COA sailing center. At the foot of the Charles creek Bridge on Riverside Avenue in Elizabeth City, NC.

Boat Divisions: Three divisions of Moth Boats will be racing: Vintage, Generation I Classic and Generation II Classic. O'pen Bic, Topaz Uno and Argo.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as changed by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

1st change: all penalties will be one tack and one jib in no order. That's a 360.
3 minute starts.

Registration: Competitors may register on site Saturday morning 9 am to 10 am at CG Park.
